## Introduction

NMPC usually conduct a small memorial service at the memorial gardens. Due to Covid-19 Dacorum Borough Council have decided not to hold an official event and NMPC have undertaken the following risk assessment and will be following suit. This risk assessment will cover a representative from NMPC attending the memorial to lay a wreath. Road closures are not required as there is no procession and there is a footpath bordering the entrance to the memorial garden.

## Details to complete the Risk Assessment

STEP 1: Rate hazard - assign a letter from A to C to denote the SEVERITY of harm or consequence of the hazard

STEP 2: Rate risk/Likelihood - assign a number from 1 to 3 to denote the LIKELIHOOD of the event causing the risk to be realised

STEP 3: Use the combination in the risk rating chart to link to the action criteria

## Action criteria:

VERY HIGH	Very high priority – Unacceptable risk: must receive attention - stop work activity or remove/reduce risk immediately	
HIGH PRIORITY	GH PRIORITY High priority - Urgent: must receive attention as soon as possible to remove/reduce hazard or risk	
MEDIUM / HIGH	Medium/high priority: Must receive attention to remove/reduce hazard or risk	
MEDIUM	Medium priority: Should receive attention to remove/reduce hazard or risk	
LOW	Low priority - remove/reduce hazard or risk after other priorities	
VERY LOW	Very low priority - remove/reduce hazard or risk after other priorities

Touching contaminated surfaces	A	3	A3	<ul> <li>Member attending should ensure that any surface touched is either wiped down or hands sanitised</li> <li>Safe hand hygiene to be practised</li> <li>No spectators should be encouraged to attend</li> <li>Member should be the only person touching the wreath (other than when the wreaths are moved by the warden)</li> <li>Warden to work within the parameters of his existing risk assessment in relation to safe working practises and covid-19 risk when moving the 'Tommies' and moving any wreaths/poppies or other items at the memorial.</li> </ul>
Contravention of current Govt. covid- 19 guidelines.	A	3	A1	<ul> <li>Formal event TO BE CANCELLED.</li> <li>Clerk to advise all usual attendees that NMPC will not be holding an event</li> <li>Facebook to be updated notifying residents that usual NMPC ceremony will not be taking place</li> <li>Should other parties be present, and Member is unable to practise safe social distancing then another opportunity to attend should be chosen</li> </ul>
Close contact with non-family members.	A	2	A2	<ul> <li>Clerk to advise all usual attendees that NMPC will not be holding an event reducing likelihood of other persons being present</li> <li>Member placing wreath to choose a time that memorial will be unattended</li> <li>Member attending to be aware of Govt. guidance in relation to social distancing/face coverings/washing hands/use of sanitiser</li> <li>Should other parties be present, and Member is unable to practise safe social distancing then another opportunity to attend should be chosen</li> </ul>
