## **AGENDA 25/007/PC** Establish the facts regarding the holiday entitlement that had been awarded which were uncovered by the clerk, when updating files etc. (Emails had been sent to all on this committee on 26.05.25) **Resolved,** had previously been granted leave using the SLCC part-time calculator, which included bank holidays in the calculation but were not deducted from allocated annual leave allowance historically. has always been allocated annual leave allowance in days, which has meant that for each day's leave has taken, has been deducted 7.4 hours (as per the SLCC calculator) from annual leave entitlement even though Review the way forward as has been paid extra holidays, in the past that had been approved by the clerk and not questioned by head of Personnel or Finance. has not had bank holidays previously deducted from annual leave allowance, but has also been using too many hours allocated annual leave per day taken. **25/009/PC** Agree the legal entitlement for holidays as of 2025. **Resolved,** using the SSLC calculator, annual leave must be calculated in hours and not days. For 2025/26 has 98 hours plus 10 hours carried forward from 24/25 (agreed by Chair of Personnel). therefore, has 108 hours annual leave and will have 20 hours deducted from this for bank holidays taken in 25/26. can choose to work BH and retain annual leave hours if wishes. The Personnel Committee will need to convert contract to an annualised hours contract, if contract is agreeable. Decide the way in which should be informed. 25/010/PC **Resolved,** the clerk will meet with on the week commencing 02/06/25 to discuss.
